Die Anteile der Frauen unter den Studierenden und Lehrenden werden, aufgegliedert nach verschiedenen Wissenschaftsbereichen und Karriereebenen, danach ausgewertet. In einem abschließenden Kapitel wird die Entwicklung von Frauenstudium und Hochschulkarrieren in Deutschland summarisch gegenübergestellt, wobei Unterschiede bzw. Gemeinsamkeiten im Ländervergleich Türkei - Deutschland ermittelt werden. Çiğdem Borchers (geb. GÜR, 1967), türkisches 'Gastarbeiterkind', besuchte in beiden Ländern die Schule.
